### 1. General description

74AHC3G14-Q100 and 74AHCT3G14-Q100 are high-speed Si-gate CMOS devices. They provide three inverting buffers with Schmitt trigger action. These devices are capable of transforming slowly changing input signals into sharply defined, jitter-free output signals.

The AHC device has CMOS input switching levels and supply voltage range 2 V to 5.5 V.

The AHCT device has TTL input switching levels and supply voltage range 4.5 V to 5.5 V.

This product has been qualified to the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q100 (Grade 1) and is suitable for use in automotive applications.









Fig. 9. Typical 74AHC3G14-Q100 transfer characteristics






Fig. 11. Typical 74AHC3G14-Q100 transfer characteristics





# 13. Application information

The slow input rise and fall times cause additional power dissipation, which can be calculated using the following formula:

 $P_{add} = f_i x (t_r x \Delta I_{CC(AV)} + t_f x \Delta I_{CC(AV)}) \times V_{CC}$  where:

 $P_{add}$  = additional power dissipation ( $\mu$ W);

 $f_i$  = input frequency (MHz);

 $t_r$  = input rise time (ns); 10 % to 90 %;

 $t_f$  = input fall time (ns); 90 % to 10 %;

 $\Delta I_{CC(AV)}$  = average additional supply current ( $\mu A$ ).






Fig. 14. Average additional I<sub>CC</sub> for 74AHC3G14-Q100 Schmitt trigger devices

ΔI<sub>CC(AV)</sub> differs with positive or negative input transitions, as shown in Fig. 14 and Fig. 15.




Fig. 17. Package outline SOT505-2 (TSSOP8)




Fig. 18. Package outline SOT765-1 (VSSOP8)
