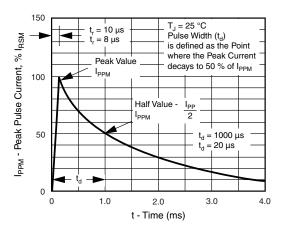


Fig. 1 - Pulse Waveform

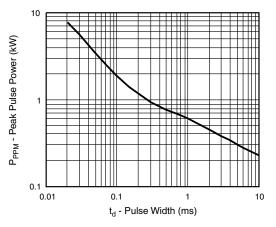


Fig. 2 - Peak Pulse Power Rating Curve

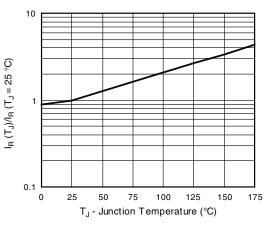
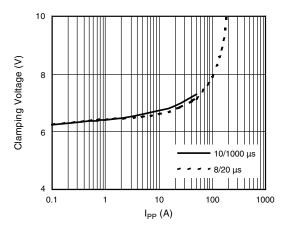
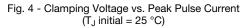


Fig. 3 - Relative Variation of Leakage Current vs. Junction Temperature





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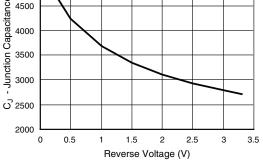


Fig. 5 - Typical Junction Capacitance

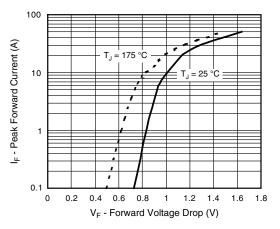


Fig. 7 - Typical Peak Forward Voltage Drop vs. Peak Forward Current

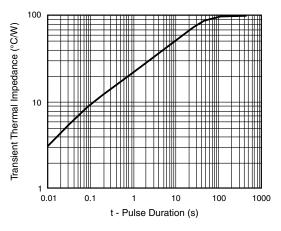
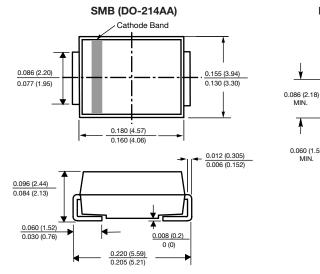
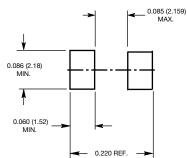


Fig. 6 - Typical Transient Thermal Impedance
