









# Test Circuit 2: IOPL




Test Circuit 3: VoH




Test Circuit 4: Vol




# Test Circuit 5: ICCH



**Test Circuit 6: IccL** 




### Test Circuit 7: tpLH, tpHL, tr, tf, PDD




