Package Outline Dimensions

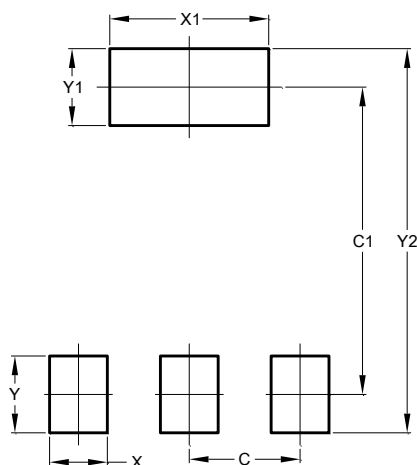
